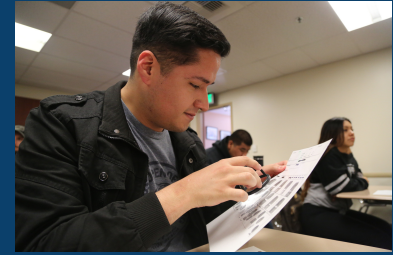

#### INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

The Financial Aid Office is currently closed for in-person services, including in-person assistance with completing financial aid applications – Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and California Dream Act Application (CADAA). Instead, we will be providing assistance via Zoom on the step-by-step process of completing your FAFSA or CADAA.

The workshops will only be for guidance on completing your FAFSA or CADAA. If you need more in-depth assistance that requires us to look into your specific account, please contact your assigned Financial Aid Technician via email, text message, or phone. A list of Financial Aid Technicians and alpha breakdown can be found under **Staff** on the Financial Aid website.

#### COME PREPARED

The following documents are needed in order to complete the application online:

- Your Social Security Card or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) (if applicable)
- FSA ID or User ID and Password to complete your application
- Driver's License/State Identification Card (if applicable)
- Your Permanent Resident Card (if you are not a U.S. Citizen) (if applicable)
- Your 2020 Federal income tax return and/or W-2 forms (include parent's tax information if dependent) (if applicable)
- Parent's Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) (if applicable)
- Parent's full name, date of birth and date of marital status (if dependent)



**TIP!** If you are filing a 2022/2023 FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application, you will need your 2020 tax information. If you are a dependent student, you will also need parents(s) 2020 taxes.

**NOTE:** If you do not have the required documents listed above, the Financial Aid Technician will only be able to provide general information about the financial aid process. Completion of financial aid documentation will not occur without required documents.

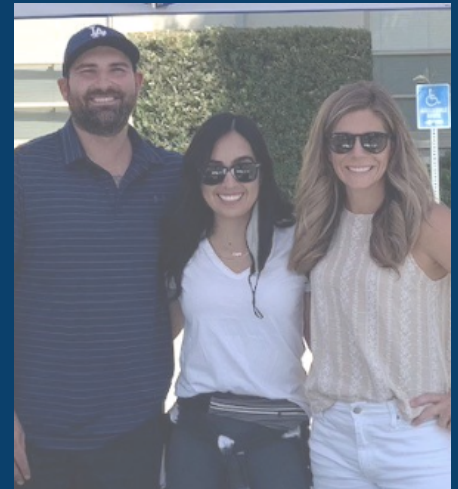

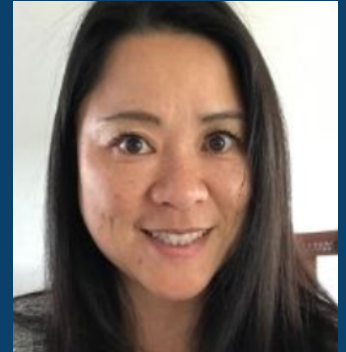
