

The following documents are needed in order to complete the application online

- Your Social Security Card or Individual Taxpaver Identification Number (ITIN) (if applicable)
- FSA ID or User ID and Password to complete your application
- Driver's License/State Identification Card (if applicable)
- Your Permanent Resident Card (if you are not a U.S. Citizen) (if applicable)
- Your 2020 Federal income tax return and/or W-2 forms (include parent's tax information if dependent) (if applicable)
- Parent's Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) (if applicable)
- Parent's full name, date of birth and date of marital status (if dependent)


