

Program Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Be a California Resident or AB540.
- 2. Be enrolled as a full-time college student (12 units)**
- 3. Have completed less than 40 degree-applicable units.
- 4. Qualify for the CA Community College Promise Grant (CCPG formerly the BOGG Free Wavier).
- 5. Must meet at least 1 of these Educational Qualifiers:
 - No high school diploma, GED or equivalent
 - High School graduates with a GPA 2.5 or below
 - First-generation college student

 - Current or Former Foster Youth


